The work submitted to this competition proves that the definition of 'photography' has broadened considerably in contemporary use. There is a tremendous diversity of technique and materials as well as stylistic applications. My selections are intended to honor this diversity. There are examples of straight photographic representation, both analogue and digital, as well as creative uses of montage, abstraction, staged images and technology. I also responded to a recurrent sense of disconnect in many of the images, where these young artists are expressing questions about gender, identity, photographic truth and our collective culture.



About the Juror

Kenda North resides in Dallas, Texas, and is a professor of photography at UT Arlington. She received her MFA from the Visual Studies Workshop (University of Buffalo) in 1976. She taught at the School of the Art Institute in Chicago and the University of California at Riverside before accepting a position at UTA in 1989. She received the Honored Educator Award from the SPE South Central Region in 2009.

Her work is represented by Craighead Green Gallery in Dallas, Texas. She has had over 50 one-person exhibitions (national and international) and participated in hundreds of juried group exhibitions since 1977. Her work is in the public collections of over 50 museum and gallery collections including the Smithsonian, the Federal Reserve, LA County Museum of Art, San Francisco Museum of Modern Art and the Santa Barbara Museum of Art. A monograph of her work was published by Gallery Min in 1988, and her work has been reproduced in a range of photographic anthologies and exhibition catalogs.


